

School Uniform



We are very proud of our smart school uniform. We have a few items that are bespoke to St Cuthbert's which may be purchased from our local stockist School Uniform Direct (SUD), in Staines. Though for much of the uniform, it can be found in high street stores.

The following items are available from School Uniform Direct: school bags, school ties, school V neck jumper and cardigan, PE polo shirt and PE maroon sweatshirt (with matching track suit bottoms).



Shoes	<p>GIRLS: Black, flat or low heeled shoes. Ballerina style slip-on shoes are not suitable. Trainers may only be worn for PE lessons.</p> <p>BOYS Black school shoes, not boots or sandals. Trainers may only be worn for PE lessons.</p>	Hair	<p>Boys' Hair: Hair should be smart and should not cover the eyes and hinder learning. Hair should be no shorter than number 2 cut. Tram lines, dyed hair and other extremes of fashion are not allowed. Hair longer than collar length must be tied back.</p> <p>Girls' hair: Hair that is shoulder length or longer, should be fully tied back. No extremes of fashion or applied hair colourings.</p> <p>Plain hair accessories in school or plain colours (Black, brown, maroon, soft pink)</p>
Coat and School Bags	<p>Dark coat/fleece Waterproof jacket (to stay in school bag)</p> <p>Burgundy drawstring PE bag (small size for KS1 and bigger size for KS2)</p> <p>Years R, 1 & 2: A mini St Cuthbert's rucksack is available for children in Years R, 1 & 2). We also recommend the burgundy book bag KS2: Larger St. Cuthbert's rucksack or any other non-branded, dark coloured (black or dark blue) rucksack that is big enough to hold large books and folders</p>	Jewellery and watches	<p>No jewellery should be worn in school (this includes earrings).</p> <p>Children may wear a plain watch in KS 2 if they are able to tell the time (no Fitbits or smart watches or step trackers that connect to the internet)</p>
